Vance C. Smith, Jr. is the current Commissioner of the Georgia Department of Transportation. He was elected to this office in June of 2009. Prior to serving as Commissioner, he was elected to the Georgia House of Representatives in November of 1992 and served the 129th district, which includes Troup, Harris, and Muscogee counties.

From 2005 to 2009 he was Chairman of the House Transportation Committee. In addition to serving as Governor Purdue's floor leader in 2006 and 2007, he also co-chaired the General Assembly's 2007 Joint Study Committee on Transportation Funding.

Smith holds a Bachelor of Science Degree in Business from Columbus State University. Beyond his career in public service, he managed a family-owned construction and earth moving business, which was in operation for 57 years.

Commissioner Smith will discuss pending transportation legislation in Georgia, GDOT revenues and revenue forecasts, the status of the Department's workforce, and new and upcoming GDOT projects. In addition, the Commissioner will be present for the cookout prior to giving his talk.
